Some equipment has inherent high-risk levels such as the Metal Bandsaw, Cold Saw, Drill Press, Mill Drill, Pedestal Grinder, Metal Lathe, Milling Machine, Mig Welder, Electric Arc Welder, Oxy Acetylene Welding, Plasma Cutter, Angle Grinder, Circular Saw, Metal Cut-Off Saw and Jigsaw. Parents are advised that the Dept of Education does not have Personal Accident Insurance coverage for students. Education Queensland has public liability coverage for all approved school activities and provides compensation for students only when the Department is negligent. If this is not the case, then all costs associated with injury are the responsibility of the parent/ caregiver. It is a personal decision for parents as to the type and level of private insurance cover for their student (if desired). Courses are funded by the Department of Employment, Small Business & Training. Students are eligible to complete one VETis funded course.
