## Certificate IV in Surveying and Spatial Information Services

We're taking expressions of interest for students interested in getting a headstart on a career in Surveying. Brisbane North West Technical Trade Training Centre is offering a 7-term traineeship starting in February 2027. Students will study CPP41721 Certificate IV in Surveying and Spatial Information Services. This course consists of 3 core and 12 electives units. It provides a Tertiary Selection Rank of 74 and direct entry to the University of Southern Queensland.

Every road, bridge, stadium and new suburb starts with a surveyor. If you want Years 11 and 12 to count for something real, this traineeship puts you in the field with drones, laser scanners and 3D technology while you finish school. You'll graduate with up to 8 QCE credits, direct university entry and a career that will set you up for life. To be eligible for this program, you must study General English and General Mathematics or Maths Methods for 4 semesters and exit with a 'C' or better.
