An accelerated senior pathway preparing young people to ignite their trade career.

Accelerated Senior for a Trade-Based Career Pathway

Students commencing Year 11 in 2027 may apply to participate in an accelerated senior program. Students will develop a trade-based pathway, aligned with their interests and strengths.



The Trade Pathways Program will be delivered at Brisbane North West Technical Trade Training Centre, in partnership with Mitchelton State High School. This is a 38-week program (one school year). Students will co-design an individual timetable that supports QCE attainment, trade training, industry placement and school-based apprenticeships. Support is provided in seeking the school-based apprenticeship that will form part of this program.

During the pilot phase, a maximum of 15 students will be accepted into the Trade Pathways Program.

Trade Pathways:

Units in prevocational qualifications can be credited to a Certificate III Apprenticeship.
